Dean Berg holds a joint appointment with the medical school at Case Western Reserve University as Professor of Law and Biomedical Ethics and Oliver C. Schroeder Distinguished Research Scholar. She is also Associate Director of the Case Western Law-Medicine Center, the oldest of its kind in the country. Following the 30 minute talk, Dean Berg will meet with pre-law and pre-med students and answer questions about applying to and attending law school and/or a joint degree program in the health law field such as the JD/MD, JD/MPH, and JD/Master of Bioethics.*
